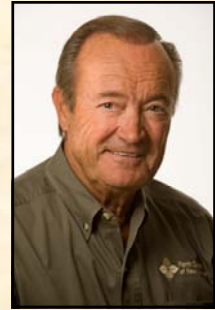


Name: Ben Haines

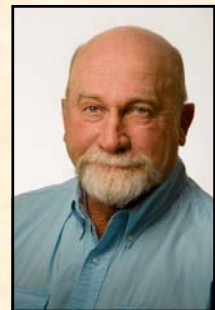


Name: Joe Clavel
